Our goal is to provide a broad range of tutoring for students desiring to improve their in-class performance. Our program is flexible enough to work with any schedule.

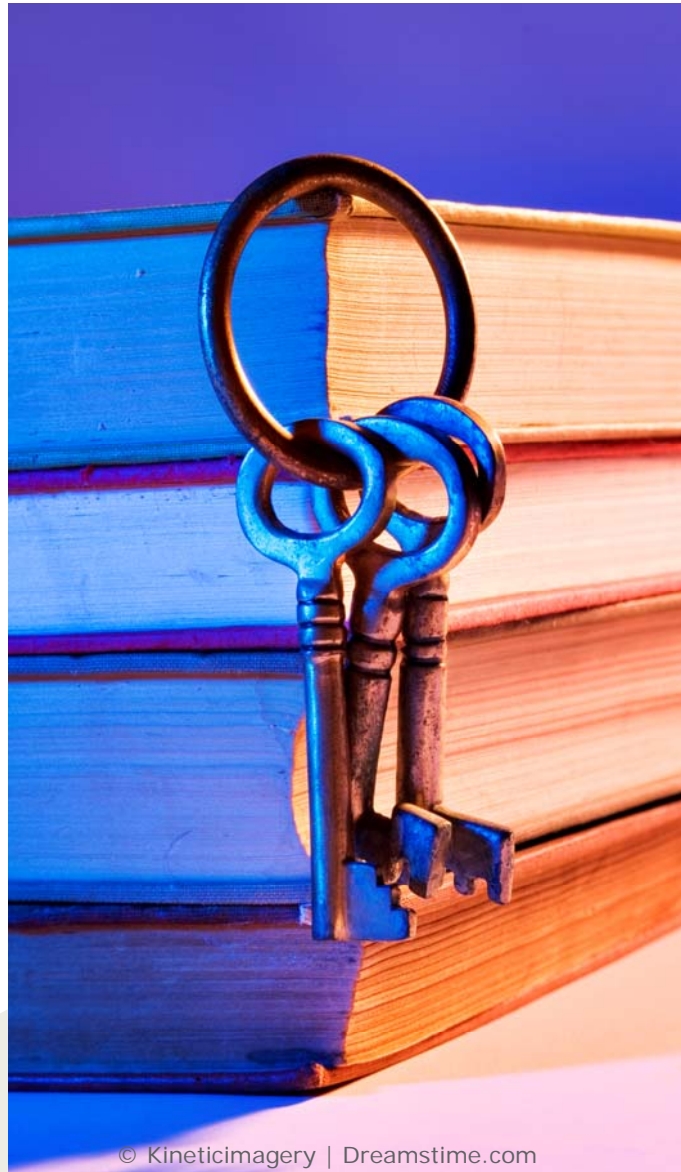
All of our tutors undergo training in district teaching methods to ensure we support current classroom standards.

DROP-IN CENTER (PERSONAL TUTORING)

We use the Buckley Youth Activities Center (BYAC) for tutoring. The center is open to all students in grades K-12 residing in the White River School District (home school, private school and public school). The center will be open during regular school terms. See the back of this brochure for days and times. The BYAC has a computer lab available. At least two adult tutors are present during all scheduled hours.

ONLINE ASSISTANCE (VIRTUAL CAMPUS)

We have established a virtual campus at our website (www.buckleytutors.org).

After free registration, students can log into the campus (from home - 24/7) and seek help from online class forums. They can also get direct help from tutors available when they log-in. If they need help beyond the forums and there is not a tutor currently available on-line, they can submit a request for help and a tutor will respond on the campus site.
